2021 Winter Walk Contest

This contest for 2021 is the same as last year (2020), allowing walkers from Oregon the opportunity to walk in any of the 4 states of the Northwest Region (Alaska, Idaho, Oregon and Washington).

Walkers will earn a "chit" for a drawing at the OTSVA State Meeting (date and location to be determined), for every "10 Walks" they have completed. (See next paragraph on page # 2) ** If more than the 10 walks have been walked, the walker will be awarded the next higher level of chits (example – 14 walks – walker will be awarded "2 chits" and so on for the number of walks

walked. List ALL of the walks you do. By doing so you might earn another chit.

The chit will be placed into the drawing by the Recognition Chairperson and drawn by the President of OTSVA) at the 2nd Quarter State Meeting and a notation of how many chits for each walker will be kept and maintained by the Recognition Chairperson OTSVA.

There are 2 (two) Walk Log Sheets, one is numbered (1-40) with each 10 walks noted and a "chit" (drawing ticket) will be awarded. The other sheet is unnumbered for those walkers who will do more than 40 walks in the contest time period of 3 months, a "chit" (drawing ticket) will be awarded for each

(drawing ticket) will be awarded for each 10 walks (or as noted above) on the additional log sheet as needed.

Please make copies of the contest information sheet and log sheet(s) for your friends who are not a member of a walking club. The more ways this contest information gets out - the more walkers will be aware of it and challenging it can be.

There will be copies available at upcoming traditional walking events in Oregon.

Seasonal Walks from 1 April to 30 September

Northwest Portland Landmark Walk (Y410) rated 2B and Parks Walk (Y297) rated 1A (revised for 2021). Both walks start at the Good Sam Medical Center, 1015 NW 22nd Ave. Currently the Medical Center is closed you can register using OSB or by contacting the POC (active) - Ed Hainline. 3. Northeast Portland Hollywood/Rose City (Y33) rated 1A (new route). Hawthorne/Laurelhurst (Y409 rated 1B) and Hollywood/Lloyd Center Y1708) rated 1A start at the Providence Medical Center, 4805 NE Glisan was open on weekends for walkers but could close at any time. Register using PSB if open. If not, use the OSB or contact the POC (active) Dick Baker. I-84 Westbound - NE 43rd Ave exit and follow signs for NE Broadway. LEFT (West) on NE Broadway for one mile. RIGHT (North) on NE 33rd Ave two miles to the McMenamins Kennedy School on the RIGHT. (See above for parking)
