Rose City Roamers 2021 Self-Guided YRE's and Seasonal Walks

Terms used:

- 1. POC the Point of Contact is a member of our club in charge of maintaining the walk. When listed below as a POC (active), you would be able to contact the member and register, get maps with instructions and complete the walk including stamping your record books. If the POC is not active, they can answer questions but would not be able to physically register you for the walk.
- 2. PSB the Physical Start Box located at the starting point for the walk. In many cases the Physical Starting Point is now closed due to Covid 19 restrictions. Once the restrictions are over, you would normally register here - get maps with instructions, complete the walk and stamp your record books.
- 3. OSB Online Start Box is using the web to register for the walk by going to and clicking on events. There are detailed instructions on how to register and get maps with instructions. It does require that you set up an account and fund it using Pay-Pal. You also are required to pay \$2 to get the maps and instructions then another \$1 after you have completed the walk to obtain your credit stamps. The first time you use this method, it seems cumbersome but after you do it once or twice it gets easy. For members walking 10 of the Rose City Roamer YRE's for AVA credit using the OSB can be reimbursed \$10 so that their total cost for credit will be \$2.

Seasonal Walk from 1 April to 30 September

1. Council Crest Walk (Y2662) rated 3B that starts at the Good Sam Medical Center, 1015 NW 22nd Ave. Currently the Medical Center is closed but you can register using OSB or contacting the POC (active) - Ed Hainline.

Seasonal Walk from 1 July to 30 September

1. Crater Lake Walk (Y2577) rated 2B for the 6km and 4D for the 11km that starts at the Rim Village Visitor Center. Register using the OSB system or contacting the POC (active) – Dick Baker

Year Round Events from 2 January to 30 December

- North Portland St Johns Walk (Y73) rated 2A and University of Portland (Y1298) rated 1A. Both walks start at
 West Coast Fitness, 7522 N. Lombard and is currently open. Register using the PSB by asking at the counter for
 the walk box and taking it outside to register, get maps and instructions, pay and stamp. If Covid 19 restrictions
 close the facility, contact POC (active) Dick Baker
- Northwest Portland Landmark Walk (Y410) rated 2B and Parks Walk (Y297) rated 1A (revised for 2021). Both walks start at the Good Sam Medical Center, 1015 NW 22nd Ave. Currently the Medical Center is closed but you can register using OSB or by contacting the POC (active) Ed Hainline.
- 3. <u>Northeast Portland</u> Hollywood/Rose City (Y33) rated 1A (new route), Hawthorne/Laurelhurst (Y409 rated 1B) and Hollywood/Lloyd Center (Y1708) rated 1A start at the Providence Medical Center, 4805 NE Glisan was open on weekends for walkers but could close at any time. Register using PSB if open. If not, use the OSB or contact the POC (active) Dick Baker.
- 4. <u>Southeast Portland</u> <u>Hawthorne & Southeast Parks</u> Walk (Y998) rated 1A starts at Fred Meyers, 3805 SE Hawthorne, is open. Register using OSB asking for walk box at counter. POC is Susan Treacy <u>Reed College Walk</u> (Y1192) rated 1B starts at Safeway, 4151 SE Woodstock. Use PSB to register at the Customer Service Counter. POC is Ethel Woods
 - Mt Talbert Walk (Y1455) rated 2B (new route) starts at Clarion Inn and Suites at front desk, 9717 SE Sunnyside Road, Happy Valley is open. Use PSB to register. POC is Judy DeBenedetti.
- 5. SW Portland Tryon Creek State Park Walk (Y921) new route, rated 1B, starts at the Nature Center, 11321 SW Terwilliger Blvd. is currently closed. Register for walk using OSB or POC (active) Ed Hainline 3 Cities, 3 Parks Walk, rated 1A (new route, Y1864), starts at REI, 7410 SW Bridgeport Rd. Tualatin is open. Register using PSB located at customer service or OSB. POC Joe & Karen Kelly Hedges Creek (Ice Age) Walk (Y1431) rated 1A and Ibach Park Walk (Y2246) starting at Starbucks, 8639 SW Tualatin –Sherwood Rd. is open. Register using PSB located near counter or OSB. POC Joe & Karen Kelly




An average walker takes approximately 1000 steps per kilometer. Taking less than 5,000 steps a day is considered sedentary.
